The Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section nine, paragraph (a) of section twenty-one and section thirty of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), as amended(b), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, hereby order:—

1. The Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(c), is hereby amended as follows:—

(b) the Fourth Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is substituted therefor.

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983.

Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinances, 1976 and 1983.

SCHEDULE Section one

FOURTH SCHEDULE

Sections fifteen and twenty-four

CONTROLLED DRUGS SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16 and 24 OF THIS ORDINANCE

1. The following substances and products, namely:—

- (a) Bufotenine
- Cannabinol
- Cannabinol derivatives
- Cannabis and cannabis resin
- Coca leaf
- Concentrate of poppy-straw
- Lysergamide
- Lysergide and other *N*-alkyl derivatives of lysergamide

Mescaline

Psilocin

Raw opium

4-Bromo-2,5-dimethoxy-*a*-methylphenethyl-
amine

N,N-Diethyltryptamine

N,N-Dimethyltryptamine

2,5-Dimethoxy-*a*,4-dimethylphenethyl-
amine;

- (b) any compound (not being a compound for the time being specified in sub-paragraph (a) above) structurally derived from tryptamine or from a ringhydroxy tryptamine by substitution at the nitrogen atom of the sidechain with one or more alkyl substituents but no other substituent;
- (c) any compound (not being methoxyphenamine or a compound for the time being specified in sub-paragraph (a) above) structurally derived from phenethylamine, *N*-alkylphenethylamine, *a*-methylphenethylamine, an *N*-alkyl-*a*-methylphenethylamine, *a*-ethylphenethylamine, or an *N*-alkyl-*a*-ethylphenethylamine by substitution in the ring to any extent with alkyl, alkoxy, alkylendioxy or halide substituents, whether or not further substituted in the ring by one or more other univalent substituents.

2. Any stereoisomeric form of a substance specified in paragraph 1.

3. Any ester or ether of a substance specified in paragraph 1 or 2.

4. Any salt of a substance specified in any of paragraphs 1 to 3.

5. Any preparation or other product containing a substance or product specified in any of paragraphs 1 to 4, not being a preparation specified in the First Schedule. ”
