The Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1991

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 9, 21(a) and 30 of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), as amended(b), hereby order:-

Amendments to Fourth Schedule to Ordinance of 1976.

1. Paragraph 1(a) of the Fourth Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976(c), as amended(d), is further amended by the insertion after the word "2,5-Dimethoxy-a, 4-dimethylphenethylamine", of "N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine" and "4-Methyl-aminorex".
