**The Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of  
Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification)  
Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section one of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), hereby order:—

1. Paragraph 1 of Part I of the First Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:—

(a) immediately after the word “Diethylthiambutene” there is hereby inserted the word “Difenoxin (1-(3-cyano-3, 3-diphenylpropyl)-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid); and

(b) immediately after the word “Trimeperidine” there is hereby inserted the word “4-Bromo-2,5-dimethoxy- $\alpha$ -methylphenethylamine”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1976.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

(3) This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.
