The Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1989

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(2) of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), as amended(b), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of March, 1989(c), hereby order:—

1. Paragraph 1(a) of Part I of the First Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, as amended ("the Law"), is further amended as follows:—

Amendments to Part I of First Schedule to the Law.

- (a) immediately after the word "Acetorphine." insert "Alfentanil.";
- (b) immediately after the words "Cannabinol derivatives." insert "Carfentanil.";

- (c) immediately after the word "Ethylmethylthiambutene." insert "Eticyclidine.";
- (d) immediately after the word "Levorphanol." insert "Lofentanil.";
- (e) immediately after the word "Racemorphan." insert "Rolicyclidine.", "Sufentanil." and "Tenocyclidine.";
- (f) immediately after the word "Thebaine." insert "Tilidate.";
- (g) there shall be added at the end the following sub-paragraphs:—

"(d) any compound (not being a compound for the time being specified in sub-paragraph (a) above) structurally derived from fentanyl by modification in any of the following ways:

- (i) by replacement of the phenyl portion of the phenethyl group by any heteromonocycle whether or not further substituted in the heterocycle;
- (ii) by substitution in the phenethyl group with alkyl, alkenyl, alkoxy, hydroxy, halogeno, haloalkyl, amino or nitro groups;
- (iii) by substitution in the piperidine ring with alkyl or alkenyl groups;
- (iv) by substitution in the aniline ring with alkyl, alkoxy, alkylendioxy, halogeno or haloalkyl groups;

- (v) by substitution at the 4-position of the piperidine ring with any alkoxy-carbonyl or alkoxy-alkyl or acyloxy group;
 - (vi) by replacement of the *N*-propionyl group by another acyl group;
- (e) any compound (not being a compound for the time being specified in sub-paragraph (a) above) structurally derived from pethidine by modification in any of the following ways:
- (i) by replacement of the 1-methyl group by an acyl alkyl whether or not unsaturated, benzyl or phenethyl group, whether or not further substituted;
 - (ii) by substitution in the piperidine ring with alkyl or alkenyl groups or with a propano bridge, whether or not further substituted;
 - (iii) by substitution of the 4-phenyl ring with alkyl, alkoxy, aryloxy, halogeno or haloalkyl groups;
 - (iv) by replacement of the 4-ethoxy-carbonyl by any other alkoxy-carbonyl or any alkoxyalkyl or acyloxy group;
 - (v) by formation of an *N*-oxide or of a quaternary base.”.

2. Paragraph 1 of Part II of the First Schedule to the Law is amended as follows:—

- (a) immediately after the words “Ethylmorphine (3-ethylmorphine).” insert “Gluthimide.”, “Lefetamine.”, “Mecloqualone.” and “Methaqualone.”;
- (b) immediately after the word “Methylphenidate.” insert “Methylphenobarbitone.”;
- (c) immediately after the word “Norcodeine.” insert “Pentazocine.”;
- (d) the word “Dexamphetamine.” is deleted;
- (e) the list of substances and products beginning with the word “Acetyldihydrocodeine.” and ending with the word “Propiram.” shall be designated sub-paragraph (a) and accordingly the letter “(a)” shall be inserted before the word “Acetyldihydrocodeine.”;
- (f) there shall be added at the end of the following sub-paragraph:
“(b) any 5,5 disubstituted barbituric acid.”.

3. (1) Paragraph 1 of Part III of the First Schedule to the Law is amended as follows:—

- (a) immediately after the word “Benzphetamine.” insert “Buprenorphine,” “Cathine.” and “Cathinone.”;
- (b) immediately after the word “Chlorphentermine.” insert “Dextropropoxyphene.”, “Diethylpropion.”, “Ethchlorvynol.”, “Ethinamate.”, “Fenethylline.” and “Mazindol.”;

- (c) immediately after the word "Mephentermine." insert "Meprobamate." and "Methypylone.";
- (d) immediately after the word "Phendimetrazine." insert "Phentermine.";
- (e) the word "Methaqualone." shall be deleted.

(2) In paragraph 2 of Part III of the First Schedule to the Law there shall be added at the end the words:

"not being phenylpropanolamine."

4. This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Extent. Bailiwick.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1989. Citation.

6. This Ordinance and the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1976(d), 1983(e) and 1988(f), may be cited together as the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1976 to 1989. Collective title.
