### **The Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1991**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(2) of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), as amended(b), hereby order:-

#### Amendment to Part I of the First Schedule to Law of 1974

1. Paragraph 1 of Part I of the First Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974, is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) immediately after the word "2,5-Dimethoxy-a, 4-dimethylphenethylamine" insert "N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine"; and

- (b) immediately after the word "2-Methyl-3-morpholino-1, 1-diphenylpropanecarboxylic acid" insert "4-Methyl-aminorex".

Citation and commencement.

2.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Bailliwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Modification) Ordinance, 1991.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st July, 1991.
