**The Motor Vehicles (International
Circulation) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Guernsey) Law, 1956(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, hereby order:—

1. In subsection (4) of section one of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")(b), the words "one pound" are hereby repealed and the words "one pound and fifty new pence" are hereby substituted therefor. Amend-
