**The Motor Vehicles (International
Circulation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Guernsey) Law, 1956(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, hereby order:—

1. In subsection (4) of section one of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(b), the words “one pound and fifty new pence” are hereby repealed and the words “two pounds” are hereby substituted therefor. Amendment

2. The Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975(c), is hereby repealed. Repeat.

- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981.
- Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinances, 1974 and 1981.
- Commencement. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
