**The Motor Vehicles (Provisional Driving
Licences) Ordinance, 1958.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration and in exercise of the powers now vested in them under the provisions of paragraph (b) of Article eight of the Law entitled "Loi Supplémentaire relative aux Automobiles (Autorisations à Conduire), 1939", hereby order:—

1. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

Interpreta-
tion.

"driving licence" has the same meaning as the expression "autorisation ordinaire" has in the Law;

"the Law" means the Law entitled "Loi Supplémentaire relative aux Automobiles (Autorisations à Conduire), 1939";

“motor cycle” includes a motor cycle combination, and an autocycle, bicycle or tricycle which is being used as or is adapted for use as a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“provisional driving licence” has the same meaning as the expression “autorisation provisionnelle” has in the Law.

2. A provisional driving licence shall be in the form specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance and the conditions which shall be incorporated therein shall be those specified in the second column of that Schedule.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

1. The holder of a provisional driving licence shall not drive any motor vehicle, other than a motor cycle or a tractor, on a public highway unless he is under the supervision of a person who—
 - (a) is present in the motor vehicle; and
 - (b) holds a driving licence authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of the same class or description as the motor vehicle being driven by the holder of the provisional driving licence.
2. An "L" plate in a form approved by the Board shall be exhibited in a conspicuous manner on the front of, and on the back of, any motor vehicle while that motor vehicle is being driven on a public highway by the holder of a provisional driving licence.
3. The holder of a provisional driving licence authorising him to drive any motor cycle shall not, while driving that motor cycle on a public highway, permit any person to be carried on the pillion of that motor cycle.

NOTICE

(This Notice is for information only and forms no part of the Licence)

In accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1936, a vehicle driven by the holder of a provisional driving licence must be insured against Third-Party risks.
