The Motorcycle Licence Plates (Guernsey and Alderney) Ordinance, 2007

THE STATES LEGISLATION SELECT COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on the States by article 18 of the Loi relative aux Automobiles, as amended^a and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and in exercise of the powers conferred on the Committee by Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended^b, and in pursuance of the Resolution of the States of 31st March, 2006^c, hereby orders:

Amendment of Traffic Véhiculaire Ordonnance of 1932.

1. (1) The Ordonnance supplémentaire à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile, 1932^d is amended as follows.

(2) In schedule 3 add the following proviso to Article (1) -

"Provided that in the case of a motorcycle within the meaning of the proviso to article 19(1) an identification mark consisting of more than four characters need not be arranged in a single line but may be arranged on two horizontal lines; and the other provisions of this Schedule shall have effect accordingly."
