**The Non-Contributory Pensions  
(Implementation) (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections three and fourteen of the Non-Contributory Pensions (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Items (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) of paragraph 5 of Part II of the First Schedule to the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinance, 1955, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(b), are hereby repealed and the following items are hereby substituted therefor:—

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970. Citation and collective title.

(2) This Ordinance and the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinances, 1955 to 1969, may be cited together as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinances, 1955 to 1970.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the eleventh day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy. Commencement.
