1992

Made 30th September, 1992.
Came into operation 30th September, 1992.

The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2)
Ordinance, 1992

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of 29th January, 1992(a) and 29th July, 1992(b), hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1989.

1. In the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989(c), as amended, (d):

(a) in Part III of Schedule 1 insert:

"3. La Rue à Gots, in the section from a point 150 metres from La Rue des Eturs,

(a) Article XVII of Billet d'Etat No. I of 1992.

(b) Article XIV of Billet d'Etat No. XV of 1992.

(c) Ordinance No. XXIX of 1989.

(d) Ordinance No. XXXI of 1990; Nos.VI and XIX of 1991; No. IV of 1992.

to a point 25 metres from La Rue de la Porte: This paragraph applies only to motor cycles.

4. La Rue du Moulin de Haut and La Rue Paintain, between a point immediately to the South-West of the disused Moulin de Haut and the junction of La Rue Paintain with La Rue des Boulains.";

(b) in Part VI of Schedule 1 insert:

- "4. La Rue des Rats (also known as La Rue ès Ralles), between its junction with La Moye Road, and its junction with La Rocque ès Cas, La Rue du Chardonnet, and the un-named cobbled road which links the second said junction with La Moye Road: This paragraph applies only to vehicles of an overall width in excess of 6 feet.";

(c) in Schedule 1 insert the following additional parts:

" Part VIII
St. SAMPSON'S

1. Le Fort, between its junction with Grand Fort Road and Maladerie Road: This paragraph applies only to motorcycles.

Part IX
St. SAVIOUR'S

1. La Rue des Vatines and the section of La Rue des Cinq Vergées between its junction with La Rue des Vatines and its junction with La Vieille Rue: This paragraph applies only to vehicles having a laden weight in excess of 3 tons.";

(d) In Part 1 of Schedule 2, immediately after the entry numbered 74, insert:

"74A. Le Truchot, between West to East
a point immediately to
the east of the rear
vehicular entrance for
the new Police
Headquarters and its
junction with Sir
William Place/Lower
Canichers. ";

(e) In Part IX of Schedule 2, immediately after the entry marked 1, insert:

"1A Bunker Hill and Les Hautes Mielles

(a) the section of Bunker Hill from its junction with the un-named road which links Bunker Hill with Les Hautes Mielles, South-East to North-West

to its junction with
Les Hautes Mielles;
