Ordinance of the States **XXVIII**

The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1957

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended, is hereby further amended by the insertion in the First Schedule thereto, immediately after paragraph seven, of the following additional paragraphs—

“ 8. La Ruelle du Gal from its junction with La Rue des Houards to its junction with La Ruelle des Fenêtres, at Le Variouf, the Forest.

9. The public highway commonly known as “The Grass Lane” which runs approximately North-East to South-West from La Ruelle du Gal to La Ruelle des Fenêtres, at Le Variouf, the Forest.”

2. Section two of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance, the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 and 1957.
