Ordinance of the States **XXIV**

1962

Made 31st October, 1962.

Coming into Operation .. 5th November, 1962.

The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1962

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:— Amend-
ments to
Ordinance
of 1956.

(a) paragraph (a) of section one thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(a) drive or ride that vehicle, or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along any of the public highways set out in the First Schedule to this Ordinance, save that the provisions of this paragraph shall, as respects the public highways specified in paragraph seven of the said Schedule, apply—

- (i) only between the hours of ten o'clock in the forenoon and midnight ending any day during the period commencing on the first day of May and terminating on the thirtieth day of September in any year, and
 - (ii) only between the hours of ten o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon on any day during the period commencing on the first day of October in any year and terminating on the thirtieth day of April in the year next following, or";
- (b) in the Second Schedule thereto, immediately after paragraph 36 thereof, there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered "37", "38" and "39"—
- "37. Victoria Road, Saint Peter Port, upwards.
 - 38. Vauvert, Saint Peter Port, downwards.
 - 39. La Couperderie, Saint Peter Port, from East to West."

Repeal.

2. In section two of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, the comma immediately after the figures "1962" where those figures first occur is hereby deleted and a full-stop is hereby substituted therefor and all the words and figures after those figures to the end of that section are hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1962, and this Ordinance, the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and

the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1961, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1962.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-two. ^{Commence-}
