The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1967

THE STATES, on the representations of the
Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. In the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended^(a), immediately after paragraph 51 thereof, there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered "52":—

"52. Monument Garden Road, Saint Peter Port,
in a clockwise direction."

2. Section three of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967^(b), is hereby repealed.

(2) This Ordinance, the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967, and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1966, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1967.
