Coming into Operation 15th June, 1968.

**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1968**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (a) of section one of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended(a), all the words from and including the words “save that” to the end of that paragraph are hereby repealed and the word “or” is hereby substituted therefor.

2. Section three of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968(b), is hereby repealed.
