**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 7 of Part VIII of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended (a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered "8"—

" 8. The more westerly of the two unnamed lanes lying between Church Road and Bulwer Avenue, Saint Sampson's, from its junction with South Quay to its junction with the unnamed road connecting Church Road with Bulwer Avenue, from South to North."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1971.
