**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, on the representations of the
Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Paragraph 36 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor—

“ 36. Rozel Road, Saint Peter Port, from South to North.”
