**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 7 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered “8” and “9”—

“8. Ruelle de la Croix, Castel, from South-East to North-West.

9. Rue de la Perruque, Castel, from its junction with Ruelle de la Croix to its junction with the lane known as Sanatorium Lane, from North to South.”.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1974.
