The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1976

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after Part X of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional Part numbered "XI"—

PART XI

THE VALE AND SAINT SAMPSON

1. Lowlands Road, in the parishes of the Vale and Saint Sampson, from North to South. ”.
