**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 9 of Part VIII of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “10”—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1970.

“10. Church Lane, Saint Sampson’s, from West to East.”

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1977.
