The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1986

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of July 1986, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 24 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph—

Amendment
to Ordinance
of 1970.

“24A. The roadway at the western end of the public markets, Saint Peter Port, between Market Street, Mill Street, The Bordage and Fountain Street, towards The Bordage and Fountain Street.”

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1986.
