**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2)
Ordinance, 1994**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the 28th day of September, 1994(a), hereby order:-

Power of Committee to amend Schedules

1. Immediately after section 3 of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended(b), insert the following additional section:-

"Power to amend Schedules

3A. (1) The States Traffic Committee may, by Order, amend Schedules 1 and 2 of this Ordinance so as to insert or delete an entry therein or to amend any such entry provided that:-

- (a) the amendment has been the subject of a temporary regulation made under the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(c) which has at the date of the Order been in force for a continuous period of at least nine months and not exceeding twelve months;

- (b) that the Order made under this section embodies, without substantial modification, the provisions of the said temporary regulation;
- (c) before making such an Order the Committee has taken into consideration any written representations made by any person; and
- (d) that the Committee has on at least two occasions before the coming into force of such Order published notice of its intention so to do in La Gazette Officielle.

(2) Section 3(2) of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 shall not have effect in relation to a temporary regulation which is embodied without substantial modification in an Order made under this section."

Amendment to Schedule 2

2. In Part IV of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, for the entry marked 1 substitute the following:-

"1. Les Nouettes, between its south to north
eastern junction with La and
Route de Farras and the first east to west
junction thereafter

1A. La Planque, between its south to north
junction with La Rue des east to west
Landes and the unnamed road and
leading to Les Nouettes north to south".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1994.
