**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1962**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. In the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended, immediately after paragraph 39 thereof, there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered “40” and “41” :—

Piette Road
and St.
Clement's
Road to be
one-way
streets.

“40. Piette Road, from its junction with Saint George's Esplanade to its junction with New Paris Road, Saint Peter Port, from East to West.

41. Saint Clement's Road, Saint Peter Port, from North to South.”

Repeal.

2. In section three of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1962, the comma after the figures "1962" where those figures first occur is hereby deleted and a full-stop is hereby substituted therefor and all the words and figures after those figures to the end of that section are hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1962.

(2) This Ordinance, the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1962, the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1961, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1962.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the thirteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
