The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1970

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970(a), as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) in Part II of the Second Schedule thereto, immediately after paragraph 5 thereof, there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “6”—

“ 6. Rue Saint Germain, Castel, from its junction with Queritez Road and Ruelle du Griffon to its junction with Rue de la Masse, from West to East.”;

(b) in Part III of the said Second Schedule, immediately after paragraph 1 thereof, there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “2”—

(a) No. V of 1970.

(b) No. IX of 1970; No. XII of 1970.

“ 2. La Planque Lane, Forest, from its junction with Forest Road to its junction with the unnamed lane to the west of La Planque Lane, from South to North.”.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy.
