**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets  
(Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby further amended as follows:— Amendments to Ordinance of 1970.

(a) in Part I of the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 66 thereof there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered “67”, “68” and “69”—

“67. Rosaire Avenue, Saint Peter Port, from South-East to North-West.

68. Dalgairns Road, Saint Peter Port, from North to South.

69. Bouillon Lane, Saint Peter Port, between the premises known as "The Green Triangle" and the south-eastern end of the Jamaica Inn car park, from South-East to North-West.";

- (b) in Part X of the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 5 thereof there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered "6" and "7"—

"6. Ville ès Pies Lane, Vale, from its junction with Rue des Petites Hougues to its junction with Rue de l'Ecole, from South to North.

7. Rue de l'Ecole, Vale, from its junction with Ville ès Pies Lane to its junction with Hougue Ricart, from East to West."

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1974.
