**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets  
(Amendment) (No. 4) Ordinance, 1968**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. The Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) paragraph 12 thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:—

“ 12. George Street, Saint Peter Port,  
from South to North, i.e. upwards.”;

(b) paragraph 38 thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:—

“38. That portion of Vauvert, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Grange Road to its junction with George Street, i.e. downwards.”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 4) Ordinance, 1968.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the tenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
