**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) (No. 4) Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. Part I of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970^(a), as amended^(b), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) paragraph 13 thereof is repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—
“ 13. North Clifton and Clifton, Saint Peter Port, from North to South.”;
- (b) in paragraph 15 thereof the words “ East to West ” are repealed and the words “ West to East ” are substituted therefor;

(c) immediately after paragraph 59 thereof there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered 60 and 61:—

“ 60. Little Saint John Street, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Union Street to its junction with Saumarez Street, in an anti-clockwise direction.

61. Saumarez Street, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Union Street to its junction with North Clifton, from South to North.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 4) Ordinance, 1970.
