**The Prohibited and One-way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1956.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-way Streets Ordinance, 1956, is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph 28 of the Second Schedule thereto of the following additional paragraph numbered 29—

“29. The street to the West of the States Office and the North Plantation leading from its junction with the Quay to its junction with the North Esplanade, St. Peter Port, from South to North.”

2. This Ordinance and the Prohibited and One-way Streets Ordinance, 1956, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-way Streets Ordinances, 1956.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 30th day of July, 1956.
