**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1957**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended, is hereby further amended by the insertion in the Fourth Schedule thereto immediately after the words “La Rue du Camu leading from Le Gron to Icart Road, Saint Martin’s” of the words “Fermain Lane.”

2. This Ordinance and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 and 1957.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the sixth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
