**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1961**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. In the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended, immediately after paragraph 34 there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered "35" and "36":—

"35. That portion of Les Petites Fontaines, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Queen's Road to its junction with Valnord Road, from West to East.

36. Mount Hermon, Saint Peter Port, from West to East."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and this Ordinance and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1960, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1961.
