**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1964**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Paragraph 8 of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended^(a), is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor:—

“ 8. White Rock, Saint Peter Port, so that—

(a) upon entering, Saint Julian's Weighbridge is on his right-hand side,

(b) upon leaving and bearing to the right, Saint Julian's Weighbridge is on his left-hand side,

(c) upon leaving and bearing to the left, Saint Julian's Weighbridge is on his right-hand side."

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964.

Collective title. 3. This Ordinance and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1962, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1964.
