**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956, as amended(a), is hereby further amended, as follows:— Amend-  
ments to

(a) immediately after section three A thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered “3B”—

“Berthelot  
Street—  
vehicles  
over  
35 cwts.  
laden  
weight  
prohibited.

3B. A person being in charge of a vehicle exceeding thirty-five hundredweights laden weight shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive that vehicle on or along Berthelot Street, Saint Peter Port.”;

(b) in paragraph 13 of the Second Schedule thereto the words “from West to East” are

hereby repealed and the words "from East to West" are hereby substituted therefor;

(c) in the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 48 thereof there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered "49", "50" and "51":—

"49. Church Square, Saint Peter Port, from North to South.

50. The road forming the western side of the triangle at the junction of Saline Road, Port Soif Road and Grandes Rocques Road, Castel, from South to North.

51. The road forming the north-eastern side of the triangle at the junction of Saline Road, Port Soif Road and Grandes Rocques Road, Castel, from North-West to South-East."

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967.

Collective title.

3. This Ordinance and the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1966, may be cited together as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1956 to 1967.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the eleventh day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
