**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended(*a*), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amend-
ments to
Ordinance
of 1970.

(*a*) in Part VIII of the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 6 thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “7”—

“ 7. Commercial Road, Saint Sampson’s, from South to North and from West to East;”;

(*b*) in Part X of the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 3 thereof there are hereby inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered “4” and “5”—

(*a*) Nos. V, IX, XII, XXV, XL and XLVII of 1970.

“ 4. La Hougue du Valle Road, Vale, from South to North;

5. The unnamed road to the North of the Plantation at North Side, Vale, from its junction with Bridge Road to its junction with North Quay, from West to East and North to South;”.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-second day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
