**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 11 of the First Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “12”—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1970.

“ 12. Mansell Street and Mill Street, Saint Peter Port, between the east end of Back Street and the bottom of Mill Street.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
