**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 5 of Part V of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “6”—

“ 6. La Grande Rue in the parish of Saint Martin from its junction with Les Merriennes Road to its junction with Rue des Câches and La Rue Cauchez, from North-West to South-East.”.
