## Ordinance of the States **IX**

### **The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended(*a*), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amend-  
ments to

(*a*) immediately after section five thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “5A”—

“Rocque-ès-  
Cas Lane—  
vehicles six  
feet wide  
or more  
prohibited. 5A. A person being in charge of a vehicle of an overall width of six feet or more shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle on or along

that section of Rocque-ès-Cas Lane, Vale, which lies between two warning signs each marked "NO ENTRY FOR VEHICLES 6 FEET WIDE OR MORE" placed near its junction with La Corderie and near its junction with the unnamed lane leading to La Moye Road, respectively.";

- (b) in Part I of the Second Schedule thereto, immediately after paragraph 63 thereof, there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered "64", "65" and "66"—

"64. Fosse André, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with La Butte to its junction with Coronation Road, from East to West.

65. Coronation Road, Saint Peter Port, from North to South.

66. Rouge Huis Avenue, Saint Peter Port, from North to South."

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.
