**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1979**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 7 of Part X of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “8”—

“8. Rue à Ronces, Vale, from North to South.”

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979.
