**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1982**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, hereby order:—

1. Paragraph 2 of Part III of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), is hereby repealed and the following paragraphs, numbered “2” and “3”, are hereby substituted therefor:—

“ 2. That portion of La Planque, Forest, from its junction with Rue des Landes to its junction with the access road leading to the States Airport Technical Block, from South to North.

3. That portion of La Planque, Forest, from its junction with the access road leading to the premises of the Guernsey Aero Club to its junction with the lane leading to Les Nouettes, from North to South.”

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982.
