**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1984**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, hereby order:—

1. In Part I of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended(a), immediately after paragraph 86 thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph numbered “87”—

“87. That portion of Footes Lane, Saint Peter Port, which lies between its junction with New Footes Lane (New Footes Lane being the new road constructed on land at Les Baissières pursuant to the Resolution of the States of the 24th November, 1982) and its junction with Les Baissières, from North to South.”.
