**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1986**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of May 1986, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows— Amendments to Ordinance of 1970.

(a) for section 4 thereof and the marginal note to that section there is substituted the following section and marginal note:

“Havelet-vehicles over six feet six inches wide prohibited.

4. A person in charge of a vehicle of an overall width in excess of six feet six inches shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer, drive that vehicle on

the one-way portion of Havelet, Saint Peter Port (that is to say, on the portion of Havelet referred to in paragraph 20 of Part I of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance.)”;

- (b) in section 5A thereof(*b*), for “of six feet or more” there is substituted “in excess of six feet”, and for “two warning signs each marked “NO ENTRY FOR VEHICLES 6 FEET WIDE OR MORE”” there is substituted “two traffic signs”;
- (c) in section 5C thereof(*c*), for “of six feet or more” there is substituted “in excess of six feet”, and for “a warning sign marked “NO ENTRY FOR VEHICLES 6 FEET WIDE OR MORE”” there is substituted “a traffic sign”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1986.
