The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th day of July, 1987, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after paragraph 10 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph—

“ 11. La Rue Traversée, (being the northernmost of the two roads lying between La Route de Cobo and the junction of La Ruelle de la Tour and La Ruelle Saumarez) Castel, from South-West to North-East.”

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.
