### **The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of April, 1989, hereby order:—

1. In Part V of the Second Schedule to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970(a) the following additional paragraph is inserted immediately after paragraph 6: Amend  
ment to  
Ordinance  
of 1970.

“7 That portion of the road through the Sausmarez Mill (or Old Mill) Housing Estate which lies between the access road to Le Hurel Estate and a traffic sign of the type numbered 42 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs and Traffic Light Signals Ordinance, 1988, from East to West.”.
