Ordinance of the States **XXXI** **1990**

Made	31st October, 1990.
Coming into Operation	1st November, 1990.

The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the 10th day of October, 1990 and 31st day of October, 1990, hereby order:—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1989

1. (1) In Part I of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989(a) (“the principal Ordinance”) the following are inserted in the appropriate places—

- (a) “26a. George Road North to South”;
- (b) “57a. Pied des Vardes South to North”;
 between Les Vardes
 and George Road
- (c) “81a. Les Vardes between South to North”.
 Les Godaines Avenue
 and Pied des Vardes

(a) Ordinance No. XXIX of 1989.

(2) In Part III of Schedule 2 to the principal Ordinance the following is inserted in the appropriate place—

“11a. La Pouqelah between Rue North to South”.
Traversée and the entrance
to Saumarez Park

Citation

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinances, 1989 and 1990.

Commencement

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st November, 1990.
