The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1993

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of January, 1993(a), hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1989

1. In the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended(b),

(a) insert in Part I of Schedule 1 -

"21. The road to the West of the North Plantation between its junctions with the North Esplanade and La Tourgand. This paragraph applies only between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m."; and

(a) Article XVI of Billet d'État No. I of 1993.
 (b) Ordinance No. XXIX of 1989; No. XXXI of 1990; Nos. VI and XIX of 1991; Nos. IV and XXVII of 1992.

(b) in paragraph 51 of Part I of Schedule 2, for the words "and States Office, North Esplanade" substitute "between its junctions with the North Esplanade and La Tourgand".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1993.
