**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1994**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the 9th day of February, 1994(a) and the 25th day of May, 1994(b), hereby order:-

**Amendments to Ordinance of 1989**

1. In the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended(c),

(a) in Part I of Schedule 1, for the entry marked 6 substitute the following:-

"Contrée Mansell, between its junctions with Mansell Street and Mansell Court.";

(b) in Part I of Schedule 2, immediately after the entry marked 4, insert the following:-

(a) Article XXI of Billet d'État No. III of 1994.

(b) Article IX of Billet d'État No. IX of 1994.

(c) Ordinance No. XXIX of 1989; No. XXXI of 1990;  
Nos. VI and XIX of 1991; Nos. IV and XXVII of 1992; No. III of 1993.

"4A. Back Street, between South to North  
its junction with Mansell and  
Street and a point 30 South-East  
metres to the East of its to  
junction with Lower Vauvert North-West";

- (c) in Part I of Schedule 2, immediately after the entry marked 29, insert the following:-

"29A. Guelles Road, South-East  
between its junctions to  
with Guelles Lane and North-West  
La Vrangue".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994.
