**The Prohibited and One Way Streets  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1970****(No. 1X  
—1970)**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in PART I of the Second Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 54 thereof, there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered 55 to 59—

“ 55. Arsenal Road, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Monument Road to its junction with Brock Road, from East to West.

56. Millbrook Estate Road, Saint Peter Port, from the house numbered 33 to the house numbered 42, in a clockwise direction.

57. La Neuve Rue, Saint Peter Port, from South to North.

58. That portion of Skin's Lane, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Courtil Bris to its junction with La Neuve Rue, from West to East.

59. The unnamed lane between Collings Road, Saint Peter Port, and the Water Lane on the East side of a property known as “Engledene” and adjacent thereto, from South to North.”;

- (b) in PART V of the Second Schedule thereto, immediately after paragraph 1 thereof, there are inserted the following additional paragraphs numbered 2 to 5—

“ 2. Les Camps du Moulin Road, Saint Martin's, from its junction with Croix Bertrand to its junction with the Old Mill, from North-East to South-West.

3. Old Mill Road, Saint Martin's, from its junction with Les Camps du Moulin Road to its junction with La Route des Camps, from South-East to North-West.

4. Rue de L'Eglise, Saint Martin's, from its junction with La Grande Rue to the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church, from West to East.

5. The unnamed road at La Belleuse, Saint Martin's, from the house known as "The Nook" situate opposite the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church to La Grande Rue, from North to South.”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy.
