**The Prohibited Streets (Bicycles)
Ordinance, 1954.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 6th day of October, 1954, hereby order:—

1. A person shall not ride a bicycle or tricycle in that portion of Le Mont Durand, Saint Peter Port, which lies between Valnord Road and Upper Manseli Street.

2. A person who contravenes the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds.

3. Section two of the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, is hereby repealed. ✓

4. This Ordinance, the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) *Repealed - See Ord. XXI - 1954.*

Ordinances, 1951 and 1952, may be cited together as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) Ordinances, 1951 to 1954.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 18th day of November, 1954.
