The Road Humps (No. 2) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th March, 1990^(a) and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(5) of the Road Traffic (Road Humps) (Guernsey) Law, 1983^(b), hereby order:—

1. The retention of—

is approved and embodied in this Ordinance.
