The Road Humps Ordinance, 1994

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of September, 1994(a) and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(5) of the Road Traffic (Road Humps) (Guernsey) Law, 1983(b), hereby order:-

Approval of road humps.

1. The retention of 3 road humps in the estate roads of Courtil Michelle, St Saviour's, and of 4 road humps in the estate road of Rue Flere, Vale, constructed there by the Island Police Committee in October, 1993, is approved and embodied in this Ordinance.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Humps Ordinance, 1994.
