The Road Humps Ordinance, 1995

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 31st day of May, 1995(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(5) of the Road Traffic (Road Humps) (Guernsey) Law, 1983(b), as amended, hereby order:-

Approval of road humps

1. The retention of six road humps in the estate roads of Rue Jehannet, St Martin's, constructed there by the Island Police Committee in July, 1994, and of four road humps in the estate roads of Chemin des Monts, Castel, constructed there in October, 1994, is approved and embodied in this Ordinance.

Citation

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Humps Ordinance, 1995.
